- ✓ Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who has supported and/or participated in rowing programs at the Bellegarde Boathouse for two years.
- ✓ Must be nominated by a rowing coach or MRRA officer.
- ✓ Must have been accepted at a college, university or vocational school.

- I. Completed and signed application form (see page 2).
- II. Typed essay (one page maximum) on the following topic:

"What has rowing brought to your life and how have you in turn been able to give back to the sport?"

- III. List any rowing activities in which you (the applicant) have participated.(Rowing team, sculling, Textile and/or Festival River Regatta volunteer staff, racing, etc...)
- IV. High School Transcript (copy acceptable).

SELECTION CRITERIA:

The selection criteria will be established by the MRRA Scholarship Committee.

All requirements must be US Post Office postmarked by April 22nd, 2016 to be considered.
